

UTAH ASA **UMPIRE REGISTRATION** INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION:

1. All of Utah's ASA Umpires must register at: www.registerASA.com
Go to the website and create a login, you will receive your own password via email. Once you have your login and password you can register.
2. The registration fee is \$65.00 for adult and youth umpires. Once you complete the registration process, you will receive your ASA Umpire ID card in the mail. You must have your ASA card with you at all times. This card verifies that you have passed a background check and are an ASA registered umpire in good standing. All coach/team personnel must have their card showing around their neck on a lanyard or clipped to their person during ASA play; leagues and tournaments.
3. The website will direct you to print off a form for a background check which you must sign. You also need to send a clear readable copy of your driver's license.
4. Print off a copy of the invoice which tells you how much you owe.
5. You are then directed to mail the following:
 - The invoice you printed off
 - Check made out to "Utah ASA" for the amount you owe
 - Signed background check form and copy of your Driver's LicenseMail to the address of your District Commissioner depending where you live). The address will show on your invoice as to where you should mail the above items.

WHEN YOUR DISTRICT COMMISSIONER RECEIVES YOUR PACKET, HE/SHE WILL THEN GO INTO THE WEBSITE AND IF EVERYTHING IS CORRECT, HE/SHE WILL APPROVE YOUR REGISTRATION.

Once approved and within 48 business hours, your registration card will be mailed to you from RegisterASA.com. (It is a good idea to make a photo copy).

After you are registered, you can pick up a copy of the ASA Official Rules of Softball from your District UIC by showing them your ID Card. You can also go online at the ASA national site www.asasoftball.com and read the new rule changes. Go to the Utah website which is www.utahasa.com and read our state code, view the current tournament circuit and much more.
